- **Second reading, Occupational Tax Ordinance (Pages 10-14):** Second reading of an ordinance to amend Chapter 22, Article II, of the code of ordinances of Garden City, Georgia, as amended, entitled "Occupational Taxes and Regulatory Fees" by defining therein the terms "Broker," "Freight Forwarder," "Leasing Company," "Motor Contract Carrier," and "Motor Common Carrier"; by changing the occupational schedule and tax cap; by clarifying the exempt status of motor common carriers under said article; by providing for interest at the monthly rate of 1.5 percent on delinquent occupational tax accounts; to repeal conflicting ordinances herewith; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes. Staff recommends approval.

- **First Reading, Amended Water & Sewer Rate Ordinance (Pages 15-18):** First reading of an ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances of Garden City, Georgia, as amended, to authorize the Mayor and Council to enforce the collection of delinquent water rent, water charges and sewer service charges for water and sewer service furnished by the City through the issuance of executions against the property being furnished such service is being provided; to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes. Staff recommends approval.
